Thursday, September 21 Tours

The group will travel to Jamestown to tour the Cummins Engine Plant and the TitanX Engine Cooling Plant. For spouses and guests who may not want to take the industry tours, there will also be a group sight-seeing tour to Niagara Region attractions.

[TitanX Engine Cooling](#) will open its world-class production facility to provide a peak into the world of engine cooling product production. Included in the tour will be a special technical program entitled *What Does Durability Testing Tell the Radiator Shop?* The scope of this technical session is to show the radiator shop technician how the results from durability testing – pressure cycle, thermal cycle & vibration – can help them to better identify the root cause of a customer’s failed radiator or CAC. Just replacing a failed unit with a new one will certainly ‘fix’ the immediate problem.

But what if the failure was a result of vibration inputs caused from a worn out isolator? By looking at what elements fail in a bench test, it can help guide the technician in identifying the 'real' problem and not only sell a new heat exchanger but also allow them the opportunity to fix and bill for additional work.

[The Cummins Engine](#) plant is one of the largest production facilities of its type in the world. Cummins builds more than 400 engines per day here. Thousands of different engine configurations are built. Engine families include ISX 15, ISX12, and the ISM. These engines are used in numerous applications including: line-haul trucks, RVs, vocational trucks, off-highway, construction, agriculture and marine. More than 1,500 people are employed at the 1 million sq. ft. facility.

To provide a less stressing Thursday, the table top reception has been moved to Friday.
